Old Red Sandstone of Scotland, 22-29 June

The trip will visit the best of Old Red Sandstone geology at locations throughout Scotland and including Orkney. Cost - £500

Isle of Wight, 25-27 June

The Isle of Wight provides spectacular coastal exposures of Early Cretaceous through to Oligocene sediments which have been important in the development of our understanding of palaeontology, palaeoecology and stratigraphic concepts, and continue to furnish new data. Cost £150

Highlights of the Jurassic Coast, 26-28 June

The Dorset Coast of southern England has become one of the classic areas for geology, with almost continuous successions through from the Middle Triassic to Late Cretaceous. Cost - £270 in single room and £220 in a shared or double room per person.
